【What is Hello! Baby Box?】

We will provide the following childcare items needed for newborns.

(Shipping is scheduled at end of November 2026.)

Content example

newborn size or S size diapers*
additive-free detergent / baby soap / wipes /
underwear set for newborns / baby gauze cloth /
thermometer / baby rattle / relaxation goods for mothers, etc

- * Please note that applicants will not be able to choose the diaper size.
- * The image is for illustration purposes only.
- * The contents of the Box may vary slightly.



【Application Requirements】

To apply to receive the Hello! Baby Box, you must meet all the requirements 1-3 below.

*Foreign nationals, persons on provisional release, or stateless persons living in Japan are also eligible to apply.

*All the applications will be screened. If the number of applicants exceeds the fixed number, the selection will be made internally. Even if the number of applicants does not reach the fixed number, those who do not meet the eligibility requirements will not be selected. Please note that we will not be able to provide details of the selection process.

1. On October 30 2026, you will be 22 weeks pregnant to about 1 month postpartum.

2. You are in either of the following situations.

*Those to whom only F applies may not be eligible depending on the number of applicants exceeds the limit.

- A. Pregnancy in adolescence (under 20 years old) or students (including over 20 years old or those who withdrew or dropped out of school after pregnancy).
- B. A household with multiple children (3 or more children under 18 years old, including the child whom the person is currently pregnant with) * if you have unborn twins, you can count them as 2 children. Even if you are pregnant with twins or more, we may only be able to provide one box per household.
- C. Unmarried or single parent
- D. Pregnancy with intellectual disability, mental illness, or mental instability (No disability certificate is required.)
- E. Your residency status is unstable (applying for refugee status, on provisional release, have no nationality, etc.) and you are unable to receive public supports.
- F. Others not listed above who have difficulty preparing newborn supplies and need assistance.

3. Income requirements

The income of applicants should be approximately equivalent to the standard set by Save the Children.

Ex: Tax-exempt household income plus about 200,000 yen

(Households receiving public assistance may apply at the discretion of the local government.)

[Documents to be submitted for application]

◆ Pregnancy in adolescence (under 20 years old) and Student under 26 years old.

1. **The cover page of your Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Mother-Child Handbook)** (Please make sure that the name of the municipality, the date of issuance, and your name are shown on the page.)
2. **If you have a spouse, partner, or other person with whom you share the same livelihood, please submit documents.** (See "2. Documents proving income of the expectant mother herself" below.)
3. **If you are pregnancy in adolescence, please submit an official document that shows your age** such as driver's license, the front of your My Number Card, mother-child handbook with the date of birth column page, resident certificate.
4. **If you are a student, please submit an image of your student ID cards.** (You may cross out the name of your school.)
5. **If you are students 26 years old and over, please submit a student ID in addition to the documents proving your income.** (See "2. Documents proving income of the expectant mother herself" below.) Additionally, if you are receiving child support allowance, please make sure to submit a child support allowance certificate.

◆ Other than "pregnancy in adolescence or students."

1. **The cover page of your Maternal and Child Health Handbook (Mother-Child Handbook)**
 - Please make sure that the name of the municipality, the date of issuance, and your name are shown on the page.
 - If you fall under "B. Multiple-children households," you must indicate on the cover sheet how many children you have.
2. **Documents proving your income such as** Withholding Tax Certificate for 2026, (Non-)taxable in FY2025 Certificate, certificate of child support allowance*, copy of tax return for 2026, certificate of public recipient. If none of the above are available, please contact us.)
3. **If you have a spouse, partner, or other person with whom you share the same livelihood, please submit documents.**

*If you are receiving child support allowance, please make sure to submit a child support allowance certificate. Those who receive partial payment are required to submit the above-mentioned documents proving income.

*If you are receiving a disability pension or survivor's pension, you must submit one of the following documents to verify your income as an expectant or nursing mother: a Pension Amount Revision Notice, a Pension Payment Notice, or a Pension Certificate. If you also have income from employment, additional documentation verifying that income is required.

* If you are unemployed at the time of application, please submit your Withholding Tax Certificate, Rishoku-hyo2 (Notice of Separation from Employment), or other documents related to your separation from employment. If you do not have these documents, please submit a (Non-)taxable in FY2025 Certificate or a Resident Tax Notification.

*E. You are in the process of applying for refugee status or on provisional release; please submit a copy of the application for refugee status or provisional release etc.
